Test Data

Approved American Board of Toxicologists in compliance with FHSA and LHAMA Regulations conducted the review of the formulation of the submitted inkpads.

In the review, the available data including the relevant data from the National Toxicology Program, International Agencies for Research on Cancer and other sources in the National Library of Medicine Data Bank were considered to assess the need for the chronic health hazard warning. The carcinogenicity, reproductive hazard, neurotoxicity, bioavailability and potential exposures were considered and in the absence of specific data, a reasonable judgement was made to assure a realistic assessment of the hazard on the ultimate art material package.

Conclusion

The amount of inks contained in each of the pads does not contain any material in quantity sufficient enough to cause **chronic toxicity** among users of this product when used as intended. Consequently, the product conforms to the health requirements of ASTM D-4236 and requires no additional labelling in accordance with the Consumer Product Safety Commission's Regulations as mandated by the Labelling of Hazardous Art Materials Act (LHAMA).
