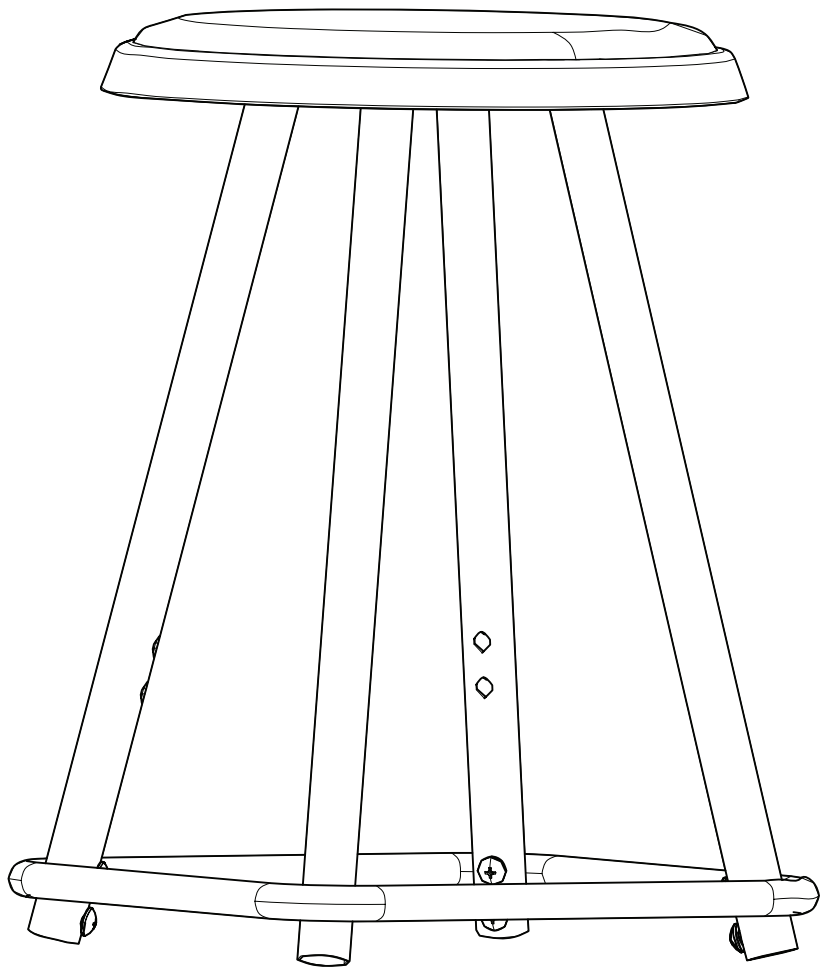

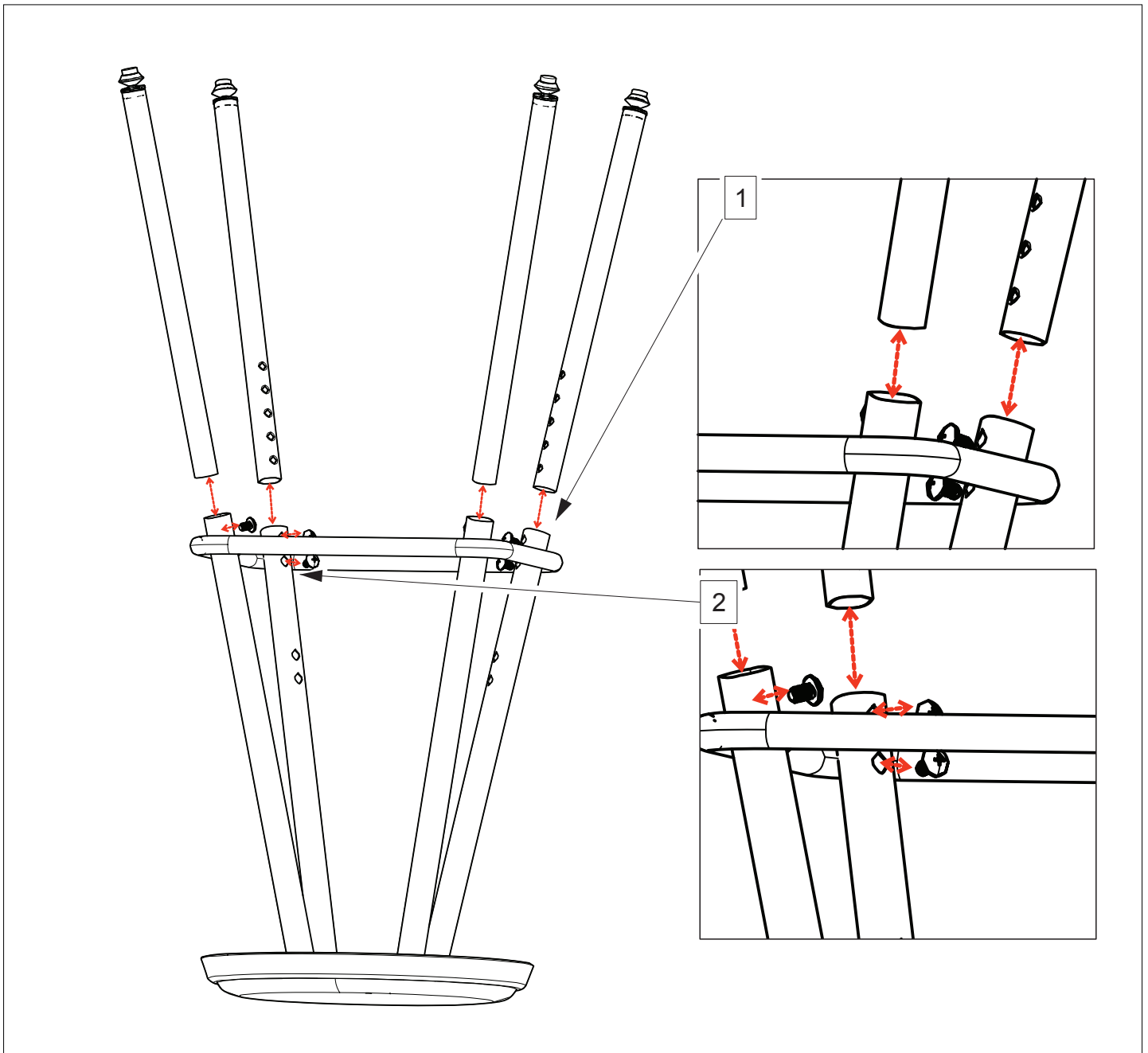
Screw for Leg Insert

STEP 1

In this step of the installation, the leg inserts with glides need to be connected to the frame. Align the leg uppers with the openings on the leg inserts, as indicated by the red arrows in the diagram. Step (1) highlights the insertion point where the leg insert should be carefully placed into the frame. Step (2) focuses on securing the connection using screws on the side. Insert and tighten the screws to ensure stability and proper alignment, leaving the screw a $\frac{1}{4}$ turn. After setting the leg height, flip the stool over, and make sure the unit is level. Then turn $\frac{1}{4}$ turn and tighten the screws, so the inserts are not wobbly.
