

STEP 1

Open drawers and remove handle screws. Swap handles to front of drawers and insert handle screws from inside of shelves to secure handles in place.




STEP 2

Remove drawers by first extending drawer to furthest setting until catch engages. To slide drawer off of rails, rotate visible catch levers on both sides of drawer either up or down while gently pulling drawer. Once both sides are free, drawer can be removed.




STEP 3

Place the top upside down on a stable, non-abrasive soft surface to avoid any scratching. Set pedestal (with drawers removed) upside down on top. Secure to top with #12x1" wood screws inserted through holes in pedestal top brackets.




STEP 4

Align Legs with pre-drilled holes and secure to Top with #10x1" Wood Screws, making sure to use eight screws per leg - not all locations are pre-drilled.




STEP 5

Align Modesty Panel flush to back of pedestal with the tab facing out, centered on the top. Secure to top using #10x1" wood screws through all available tab holes.




STEP 6

Install Casters to bottom of pedestal. Use Locking Casters in front of pedestal and Non-Locking Casters in the back. Secure casters with metal tap screws.




STEP 7

Install Casters to bottom of legs, making sure to include the split-lock washer. Use Locking Caster on front leg and Non-Locking Casters on the back. Secure casters with provided caster wrench.




STEP 8

Insert Plastic Caps into holes on both sides of the pedestal. Additional holes are present on the hidden side of the pedestal in the view below



STEP 9

Return unit to an upright position, insert drawers back into pedestal boxes, and place accessories as desired within drawers.
