Make an Animal Puppet

Steps to Make an Animal Puppet

DAY 1

1

Choose four 9" x 12" colored sheets for your animal.







2 Set one sheet to the side for the puppets backing, lay one flat vertically for the puppets front, and add texture to the other two 9" x 12" sheets with markers and/or crayons.



Supplies:

- 9" x 12" Smart-Fab pack in assorted colors
- Glue
- Google Eyes
- Scissors or a Rotary Cutter & Mat
- Crayons and/or markers



Place the two textured pieces vertically and cut slightly jagged horizontal into approximately 9" x 3" strips.

Steps to Make an Animal Puppet

- Roughly cut fringe into strips leaving an inch at the top for gluing.
- Draw a line of glue across the bottom of the piece, set aside for the front of the puppet.

6 Lay first strip along the glue.





Repeat by adding layers of fringe. Each strip will slightly overlap the top of the previous strip until you reach the top. 8 Add any desired animal features as a second layer including googly eyes (ears, nose, mouth, teeth, tongue).



Let dry completely.

DAY 2

Add a line of glue on the sides and the top, leaving the bottom edge open. Place second sheet directly on top.



11 Let dry completely.

Show Off Your Puppet!

This is a great opportunity for students to use their imagination and create a puppet.
