**Objective:** Make an imaginative super hero cape and save the day

# Make a Superhero Cape

## Supplies:

- 24"x32" rectangles (can be longer or shorter depending on the height of student)
- Smart-Fab in assorted pack in various colors
- Templates for student's neck that is pre-drawn and cut out of 12"x18" paper
- Scissors
- Markers
- Glue
- Velcro Sticky Back Coins



## Steps to Make a Superhero Cape



- 1** Give each student a pre-cut 24"x32" piece of Smart-Fab from roll.



- 2** Have students fold the 24" side of the Smart-Fab rectangle in half so they have a 12"x32" rectangle

## Steps to Make a Superhero Cape

- 3 Line up template for neck enclosure at the top. Take note where the fold is and make sure neck opening is lined up on the fold.



- 4 Trace template using a marker.

- 5 Cut Smart-Fab along lines and cut apart neck enclosure at the top.



- 6 Open up Smart-Fab and lay flat on a placemat.

- 7 Have students create their own logo or Superhero symbol using assorted pack of Smart-Fab.



- 8 Cut logo/symbol then glue to the middle of the cape at the neck.



- 9 Add velcro enclosures to the cape at the neck.
