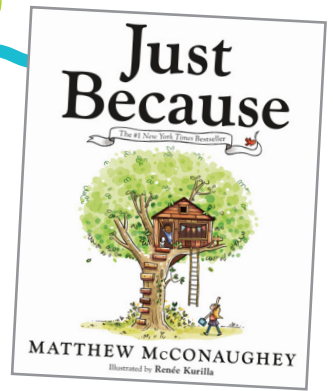




Creative Leadership

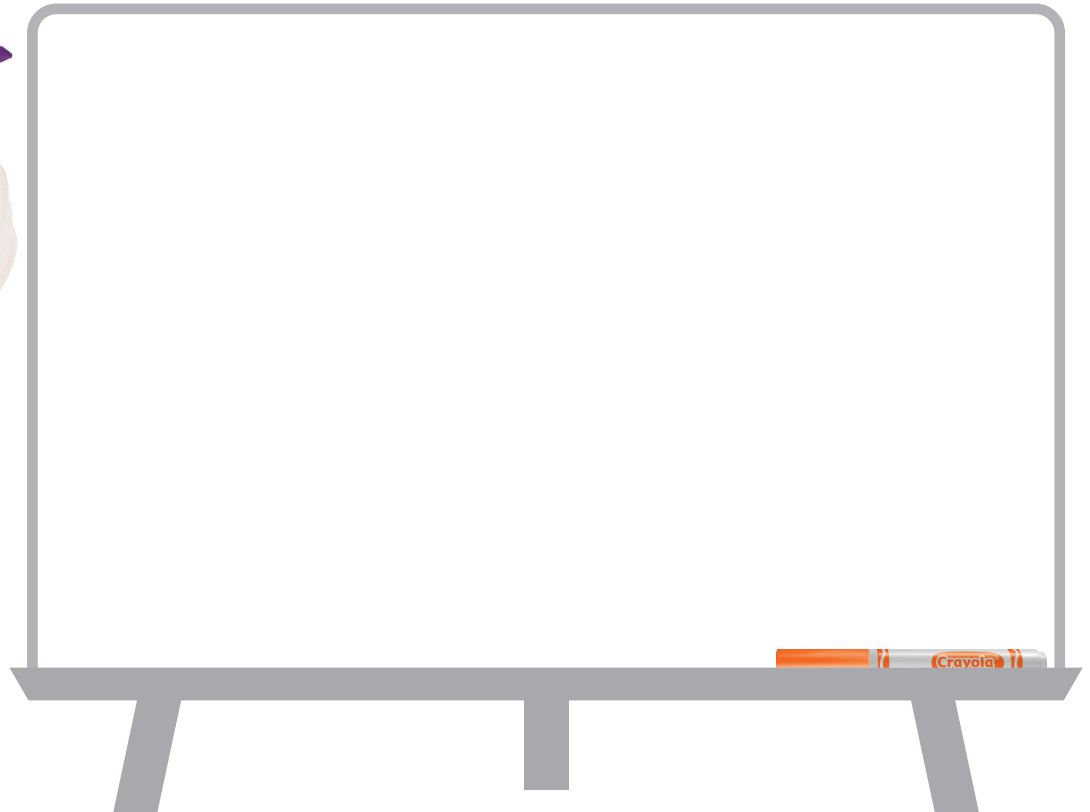
RESPOND to author Matthew McConaughey's statement that "we are all leaders" and we should "celebrate all the creative ways people lead!"
